What is
legalization?

Legalization of documents

refers to assigning legal status in a given country to a document issued in another country.

“

NB Documents may only be legalized in the same country where they were issued

NB Documents are legalized depending on the country where they will be used

WHO DOES NOT NEED IT?

Those, who are going to use documents in countries which have concluded a bilateral treaty with Russia, removing the need for legalisation

IN OTHER CASES

before leaving Russia

THERE ARE SEVERAL WAYS TO
DO IT

... if country where you plan to use documents did not sign the Hague Convention, you need **consular legalization**

...and if it did, you need an **Apostille.**



HOW TO DO IT



HSE will help you to make an **Apostille**: you will not have to go anywhere, just follow the command of International Office staff and fill in requested documents in time



- ❑ Unfortunately, HSE can not legally help you to do **Consular Legalization** and you need to plan to travel to Moscow after graduation
- ❑ However, International office will consult you on the necessary steps and will help you to fill out all the documents
