WHAT WILL YOU STUDY

This is a unique English-taught programme in Russia that provides comprehensive, truly interdisciplinary approach to studying business and politics in modern Asia. It concentrates both on the general processes that take place in Asia as well as on the specifics of particular countries, primarily China, Japan, Korea, and the countries of Southeast Asia.

The programme focuses mainly on business and political processes in Asia, including business and entrepreneurship, political and financial elites of the region, national-specific issues and intercultural communication between Europe, Russia and Asia.

The programme combines two main approaches: academic and applied. On the one hand, the programme covers the fundamentals of political, economic, social and national-specific processes in Asia. On the other hand, it develops practical skills for cooperation with Asian countries, both at the level of political and business consulting, as well as at the level of everyday business.
