

Anna Daviy is a senior lecturer at the Department of Management and junior research fellow in the International Laboratory of Intangible-Driven Economy, St. Petersburg and Perm campus. Her previous research focused on consumer behavior in the ecommerce market, and she has some publications in Russian peer-reviewed journals on this topic. At this moment, she is working on the topic of digital transformation. The most recent paper published by a research team that included Anna and Elena Shakina discusses how the moment that companies choose to initiate a technological change relative to other companies from the same regional and industrial context influences the company's performance. Her latest paper, which is under revision, aims to explore the effect the regional environment has on technology-driven performance, measured by enterprise resource planning (ERP). Her teaching is mainly devoted to the field of business models, business research methods, and marketing research.
