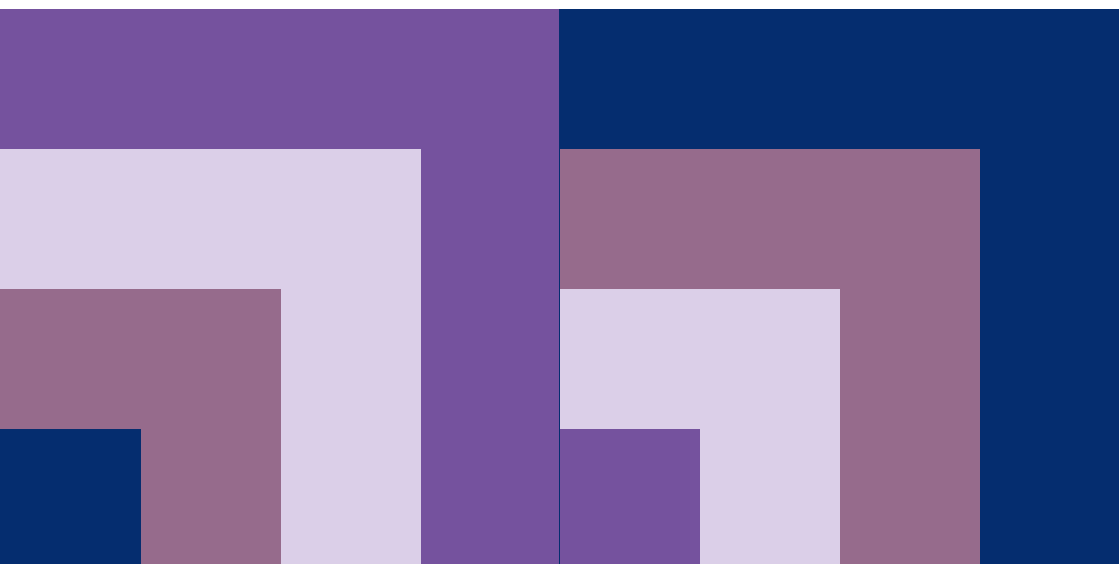

This programme grounds students in the vibrant field of global history through a regional focus on Russian, former Soviet and Eurasian spaces, and in possibility to major in history or anthropology. It draws on the proximity and wealth of archives and museum collections of St Petersburg and its rich environs, and on our academic strength in history and anthropology. Students benefit from the ease of travel to Moscow, Finland, the Baltics and multiple regional locations within Russia.
