5. Scholarly Writing Style: Tips

"Since vs. because. Since is more precise when it is used to refer only to time (to mean "after that"); otherwise, replace it with because.

Correct: Data for two participants were incomplete because these participants did not report for follow-up testing.

Incorrect: Data for two participants were incomplete since these participants did not report for follow-up testing."
