About. "Toward a Multiethnic History of Russia and the USSR" is a two-day conference hosted by the Centre for Historical Research at the National Research University Higher School of Economics in St. Petersburg. The conference will bring together historical scientists to present critical research on the history of Russia as a multiethnic state, from Peter the Great to the dissolution of the Soviet Union.

Topics. Subjects of papers might include, but are certainly not limited to: Multiethnicity and interethnic relations in the Russian Empire and the USSR; National policy in the Russian and Soviet history; Dilemmas and opportunities of empires and multinational states; Russian Ethnography and its national contexts

Submission Details. Participation is open to scholars, PhD students, and advanced MA and BA students from all universities and research institutions in the Russian Federation and the Republic of Armenia. Submissions must include **(1)** the topic of research, **(2)** an abstract (up to 500 words), and **(3)** name, institutional affiliation, and position. Submissions can be sent in **Russian or English**. Please note that HSE **does not** send feedback for submissions and **cannot** cover travel and accommodation costs.
