Visa, Insurance & Other Information				
What kind of visa do the students need to obtain?	Exchange students will be required to apply for a Malaysian Student Pass - IM 14 (M)			
	TAR UMT will assist in the application for the Student Pass. Successful applicants shall be granted an Electronic Visa Approval Letter (eVAL) to be used to enter Malaysia.			
	Before arrival in Malaysia, students must use the approved eVAL to apply for a Single-Entry Visa (SEV) either <u>online</u> or the nearest Malaysian Embassy/Consulate. Failure to comply will result in cancellation of Student Pass.			
	The estimated costing for student visa & medical insurance will be around MYR $1,600-3,300$ depending on nationality & duration of studies.			
Insurance for Exchange Student(s)	It is COMPULSORY for all international students to have medical insurance coverage throughout the period of study in Malaysia. All inbound exchange students will be required to purchase a medical insurance coverage advised by TAR UMT through the EMGS system during the e-VAL application process. Students are encouraged to purchase a suitable travel insurance plan to cover their trip to Malaysia which is not included in the medical insurance offered by EMGS.
