Introduction

The University of Nizwa was established in 2004. It is located in the historic former capital of Oman.

Nizwa City

The city of Nizwa is the regional centre of A'Dakhiliyah Governorate. It lies around 164 kilometres from the capital Muscat. Nizwa lies at the foot of Al Jabal Al Akhdar (Green Mountain) to the south, amongst the mountains that form its walls. The city is full of rivers, orchards and palm trees towering amidst a balmy atmosphere. This clement weather has made a number of scholars and holy and free men claim Nizwa their hometown, giving it the name "the courtyard of Islam".

Nazwa city is famous for its history, culture, origins and heritage that abound in its customs, traditions, crafts, and the traditional industries and handicrafts our forefathers have known and excelled in as a means of livelihood.

In his famous book "Masterpiece Spectacles in Foreign Lands and the Wonders of Travel" Ibn Battuta describes his trip to Nizwa and what he saw there. He says: "Then we headed to Oman country and walked for six days in the desert. We reached the country of Oman on the seventh day. It is a fertile land with rivers, trees, orchards, palm plantations, and all kinds of fruit. We reached the city of Nizwa, considered to be the main city in this country. Here, people usually eat in the mosques, where each one brings whatever food he has to eat in the mosque courtyard. Everybody shares the food and these people are helpful and courageous."



Our Exchange Experience

The university has various experiences in student's exchange programs. At UoN, exchange programs could be implemented in many ways. Usually, the University make the traditional way of exchange, locally with Omani Institutions or externally with Foreign Institutions.

However, one of the most interesting ways is what we call Virtual Exchange Programs. This type of exchange provides the students the opportunity to have a course with students from other countries for the entire semester without the need to travel ever. However, students study with each other in two connected classrooms all over the semester.

One of the exchange experiences we're proud of is the International Horizons Program which was established in 2008. This program was designed to benefit UoN students not only in academic regards, but culturally as well. The program provided almost 400 students to travel and study in other countries and observe other cultures, religions and ethnicities. Therefore, it cannot be considered as an academic program only. It's much more than that.

Nomination and Application

Students should be nominated by the Home Institution. Students' Names, Passports, Degree programs and the desired courses should be provided with the nomination letter/email.

Deadline

Nomination and Application have the same deadline date. The deadline dates are July 1st for Fall semester and December 1st for Spring semester.



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

Residence Card	Expires after ONE year.	20 OMR


