Skype with web-camera or similar available communication tool (Zoom) is used in order to conduct the interview. The interview might also be conducted internally. 4. During the interview the applicant has an opportunity to give the comprehensive comments on the application and the motivation letter; to show the understanding of the educational specialization; to show strong communication skills in English For the <u>Master's programmes</u> <u>'Comparative Politics of Eurasia':</u> recommended duration of the interview – 30 minutes; during the interview, the Commission tests the applicant for 15 minutes on issues that include the basics of comparative politics and international relations, in the format of multiple choice test and then talks with the applicant on the substantive aspects of his application (on portfolio elements);	Fail – 50 (0 - 25 based on test results; 0 - 25 based on discussion)
